NTIS netballers score national selection

NTIS Netball Scholarship holders Kim Bruyn and Jessica Moller secured a place at the National Underage Talent Camp after impressing national selectors at the recent Netball Australia National Underage Championships in Perth.

Both girls captained their respective teams at the Championships, with Kim captaining the Northern Territory 19 and under side and Jess taking the helm of the 17 and under team. Their stand out performances at the championships earning the girls a place in their respective 25 member squads to participate in the camp to be held at the Australian Institute of Sport in Canberra from the 8 – 11 July 2008.

NTIS Head Coach Stacey West was elated at the selections and said the camp will give the girls the opportunity to go head to head against the best upcoming talent in Australia.

“Kim has developed immensely since she attended the same camp in 2006, and with her recent selection to the Golden South Jaguars in the Queensland State League, I am sure she will continue to attract interest from national selectors,” said Ms West.

“For Jess this is a great chance to show her potential and pit her skills against the best in Australia. She is an amazing athlete who works hard and is committed to her program, and is now starting to reap the rewards”.

Participants will undergo physical and strength testing, position specific skills sessions, and match play during the week long camp which will be overseen by National Coach Norma Plummer and Australian Under 21 and AIS coach Simone McKinnon.

“As well as national selectors, you have the attention of every Academy and Institute coach in Australia at this camp, so it is a great chance for the girls to develop networks to further their netball career,” said Ms West.
